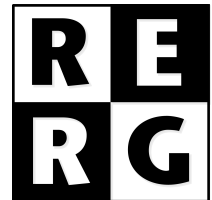

- Reduced fee for students



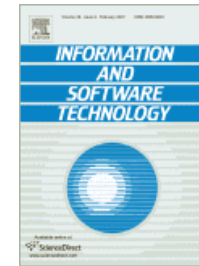

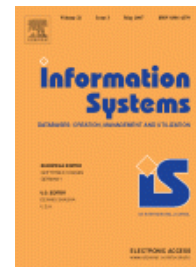

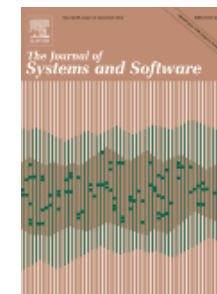
