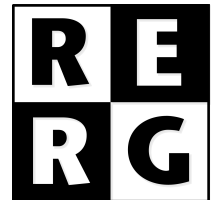

- Reduced fee for students

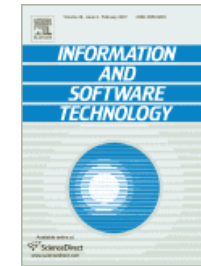

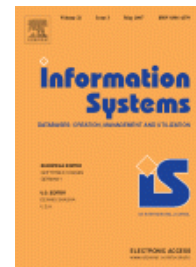

 - Works only from the domain uzh.ch, use VPN from home
