



# Journals – The flagship journal: REJ


- Requirements Engineering Journal (Springer)

- IEEE Software Magazine (IEEE)
- Publishes practitioner-oriented research and experience
- Geared towards practitioners

- Included in IEEE membership
- Reduced fee for students
