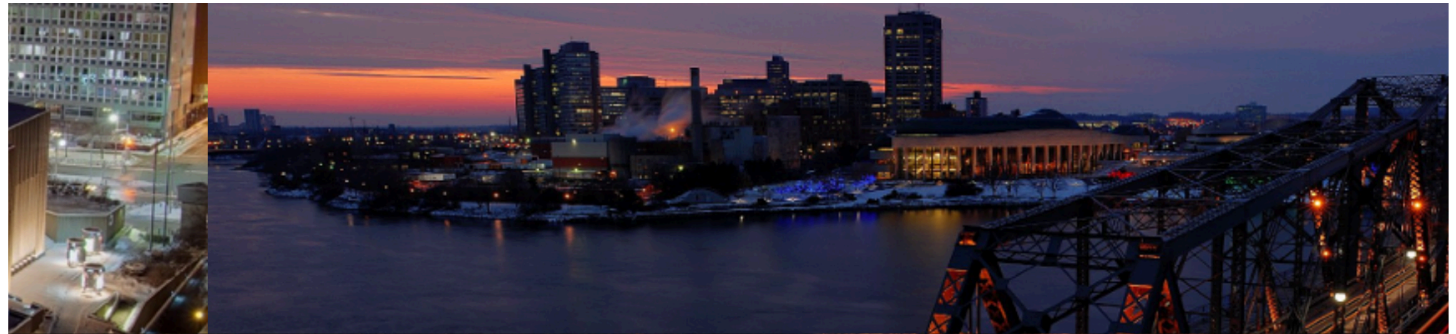

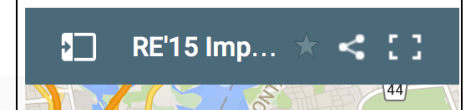

- Geared towards practitioners

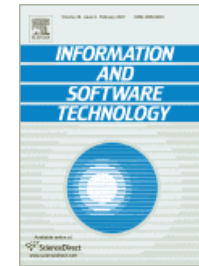

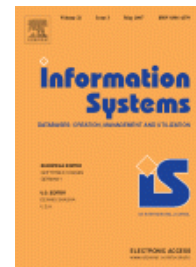
